## **Volunteer Florida**

Volunteer Florida was established in 1994 by the Florida Legislature to administer grants under the National and Community Service Trust Act of 1993.

Volunteer Florida is the Governor's lead agency for volunteerism and national service in Florida.

Volunteer Florida is governed by a Board of Commissioners appointed by the Governor and approved by the Florida Senate.




- 1) Administers AmeriCorps programs
- 2) Coordinates volunteers and donations before, during and after disasters
- 3) Increases volunteerism through grants, trainings and recognitions
- 4) Manages the Volunteer Florida Foundation



# 1) AmeriCorps in Florida



National service programs like AmeriCorps offer Floridians the opportunity to engage in intensive service to their community while increasing capacity for nonprofits and other service organizations.



# 2) Emergency Management

Volunteer Florida is the lead agency for Emergency Support Function (ESF) 15, Volunteers and Donations, for the Florida Division of Emergency Management.



## **ESF 15** Roles and Responsibilities

- Coordinates with local and state government emergency management agencies to meet volunteer and donation needs
- Operates the Florida Volunteers and Donations Hotline: 1-800-FL-HELP-1
- Administers the Florida Disaster Fund
- Provides training and presentations on volunteer and donations management





## 3) Promoting Volunteerism

Volunteer Florida promotes volunteerism across Florida.

#### Activities include:

- Participate with local, regional, and statewide partners to address critical needs through volunteering and service
- Serve as speakers, advocates and educators on volunteer engagement
- Publicly recognize volunteers to increase visibility and engagement
- Support Volunteer Centers
- Liaise with the Florida Association for Volunteer Resource Management
- Implement Governor's Office and other high-level requests for volunteer programs and promotions



## **Volunteer Generation Fund**

VGF Focuses on increasing the capacity of organizations to recruit, manage, support and retain skills-based volunteers to serve in high-value volunteer assignments.
